“I have made a covenant with my chosen one; \*  
I have sworn an oath to David my servant:  
‘I will establish your line for ever, \*  
and preserve your throne for all generations.’”  
The heavens bear witness to your wonders, O LORD, \*  
and to your faithfulness in the assembly of the holy ones;  
For who in the skies can be compared to the LORD? \*  
who is like the LORD among the gods?

Who is like you, LORD God of hosts? \*  
O mighty LORD, your faithfulness is all around you.  
You rule the raging of the sea \*

### **The First Lesson**

**John 14:6-14**

A Reading from the Gospel According to John.

Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you know me, you will know my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him.” Philip said to him, “Lord, show us the Father, and we will be satisfied.” Jesus said to him, “Have I been with you all this time, Philip, and you still do not know me? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, Show us the Father’? Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own; but the Father who dwells in me does his works. Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; but if you do not, then believe me because of the works themselves.

Very truly, I tell you, the one who believes in me will also do the works that I do and, in fact, will do greater works than these, because I am going to the Father. I will do whatever you ask

in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If in my name you ask me for anything, I will do it.
