### Confession of Sin

Let us confess our sins against God and our neighbor.

 Princely state has been yours from the day of your birth; \*  
 in the beauty of holiness have I begotten you, like dew from the womb of the morning."  
 The LORD has sworn and he will not recant: \*  
 "You are a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek."  
 The Lord who is at your right hand will smite kings in the day of his wrath; \*  
 he will rule over the nations.  
 [He will heap high the corpses; \*  
 he will smash heads over the wide earth.  
 He will drink from the brook beside the road; \*  
 therefore he will lift high his head.]

**Psalm 116**

**BCP p. 759**

I love the LORD, because he has heard the voice of my supplication, \*  
 because he has inclined his ear to me whenever I called upon him.  
 The cords of death entangled me; the grip of the grave took hold of me; \*  
 I came to grief and sorrow.  
 Then I called upon the Name of the LORD: \*  
 "O LORD, I pray you, save my life."  
 Gracious is the LORD and righteous; \*  
 our God is full of compassion.  
 The LORD watches over the innocent; \*  
 I was brought very low, and he helped me.  
 Turn again to your rest, O my soul. \*  
 for the LORD has treated you well.  
 For you have rescued my life from death, \*  
 my eyes from tears, and my feet from stumbling.  
 I will walk in the presence of the LORD \*  
 in the land of the living.  
 I believed, even when I said, "I have been brought very low." \*  
 In my distress I said, "No one can be trusted."  
 How shall I repay the LORD \*  
 for all the good things he has done for me?  
 I will lift up the cup of salvation \*  
 and call upon the Name of the LORD.  
 I will fulfill my vows to the LORD \*  
 in the presence of all his people.  
 Precious in the sight of the LORD \*  
 is the death of his servants.  
 O LORD, I am your servant; \*  
 I am your servant and the child of your handmaid; you have freed me from my bonds.  
 I will offer you the sacrifice of thanksgiving \*  
 and call upon the Name of the LORD.  
 I will fulfill my vows to the LORD \*  
 in the presence of all his people,  
 In the courts of the LORD'S house, \*  
 in the midst of you, O Jerusalem. Hallelujah!

**Psalm 117****BCP p. 760**

Praise the LORD, all you nations; \*  
    laud him, all you peoples.  
For his loving-kindness toward us is great, \*  
    and the faithfulness of the LORD endures for ever. Hallelujah!

**The Lesson****Mark 1:14-28**

A Reading from the Gospel According to Mark.

Now after John was arrested, Jesus came to Galilee, proclaiming the good news of God, and saying, 'The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news.'

As Jesus passed along the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the lake—for they were fishermen. And Jesus said to them, 'Follow me and I will make you fish for people.' And immediately they left their nets and followed him. As he went a little farther, he saw James son of Zebedee and his brother John, who were in their boat mending the nets. Immediately he called them; and they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired men, and followed him.

They went to Capernaum; and when the sabbath came, he entered the synagogue and taught. They were astounded at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes. Just then there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit, and he cried out,

'What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are, the Holy One of God.' But Jesus rebuked him, saying, 'Be silent, and come out of him!' And the unclean spirit, throwing him into convulsions and crying with a loud voice, came out of him. They were all amazed, and they kept on asking one another, 'What is this? A new teaching—with authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey him.' At once his fame began to spread throughout the surrounding region of Galilee.
