### Thursday after the Third Sunday in Lent

### Confession of Sin

Let us confess our sins against God and our neighbor.

**Most merciful God,  
we confess that we have sinned against you  
in thought, word, and deed,  
by what we have done,  
and by what we have left undone.  
We have not loved you with our whole heart;  
we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.  
We are truly sorry and we humbly repent.  
For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ,  
have mercy on us and forgive us;  
that we may delight in your will,  
and walk in your ways,  
to the glory of your Name. Amen.**

Almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us all our sins through our Lord Jesus Christ, strengthen us in all goodness, and by the power of the Holy Spirit keep us in eternal life. **Amen.**

and turned yourself from your wrathful indignation.  
Restore us then, O God our Savior; \*  
let your anger depart from us.  
Will you be displeased with us for ever? \*  
will you prolong your anger from age to age?  
Will you not give us life again, \*  
that your people may rejoice in you?  
Show us your mercy, O LORD, \*  
and grant us your salvation.  
I will listen to what the LORD God is saying, \*  
for he is speaking peace to his faithful people and to those who turn their hearts to him.  
Truly, his salvation is very near to those who fear him, \*  
that his glory may dwell in our land.  
Mercy and truth have met together; \*  
righteousness and peace have kissed each other.  
Truth shall spring up from the earth, \*  
and righteousness shall look down from heaven.  
The LORD will indeed grant prosperity, \*  
and our land will yield its increase.  
Righteousness shall go before him, \*  
and peace shall be a pathway for his feet.

**BCP p. 709**

Bow down your ear, O LORD, and answer me, \*  
for I am poor and in misery.  
Keep watch over my life, for I am faithful; \*  
save your servant who puts his trust in you.  
Be merciful to me, O LORD, for you are my God; \*  
I call upon you all the day long.  
Gladden the soul of your servant, \*  
for to you, O LORD, I lift up my soul.  
For you, O LORD, are good and forgiving, \*  
and great is your love toward all who call upon you.  
Give ear, O LORD, to my prayer, \*  
and attend to the voice of my supplications.  
In the time of my trouble I will call upon you, \*  
for you will answer me.  
Among the gods there is none like you, O LORD, \*  
nor anything like your works.  
All the nations you have made will come and worship you, O LORD, \*  
and glorify your Name.  
For you are great; you do wondrous things; \*  
and you alone are God.  
Teach me your way, O LORD, and I will walk in your truth; \*  
knit my heart to you that I may fear your Name.

I will thank you, O LORD my God, with all my heart, \*  
and glorify your Name for evermore.  
For great is your love toward me; \*  
you have delivered me from the nethermost Pit.  
The arrogant rise up against me, O God, and a band of violent men seeks my life; \*  
they have not set you before their eyes.  
But you, O LORD, are gracious and full of compassion, \*  
slow to anger, and full of kindness and truth.  
Turn to me and have mercy upon me; \*  
give your strength to your servant; and save the child of your handmaid.  
Show me a sign of your favor, so that those who hate me may see it and be ashamed; \*  
because you, O LORD, have helped me and comforted me.  
Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: \*  
as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be for ever. Amen.

### **The Lesson**

### **1 Cor. 9:1-15**

A Reading from the First Letter to the Corinthians.

Am I not free? Am I not an apostle? Have I not seen Jesus our Lord? Are you not my work in the Lord? If I am not an apostle to others, at least I am to you; for you are the seal of my apostleship in the Lord.

This is my defense to those who would examine me. Do we not have the right to our food and drink? Do we not have the right to be accompanied by a believing wife, as do the other apostles and the brothers of the Lord and Cephas? Or is it only Barnabas and I who have no right to refrain from working for a living? Who at any time pays the expenses for doing military service? Who plants a vineyard and does not eat any of its fruit? Or who tends a flock and does not get any of its milk? Do I say this on human authority? Does not the law also say the same? For it is written in the law of Moses, "You shall not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain." Is it for oxen that God is concerned? Or does he not speak entirely for our sake? It was indeed written for our sake, for whoever plows should plow in hope and whoever threshes should thresh in hope of a share in the crop. If we have sown spiritual good among you, is it too much if we reap your material benefits? If others share this rightful claim on you, do not we still more? Nevertheless, we have not made use of this right, but we endure anything rather than put an obstacle in the way of the gospel of Christ. Do you not know that those who are employed in the temple service get their food from the temple, and those who serve at the altar share in what is sacrificed on the altar? In the same way, the Lord commanded that those who proclaim the gospel should get their living by the gospel.

But I have made no use of any of these rights, nor am I writing this so that they may be applied in my case. Indeed, I would rather die than that—no one will deprive me of my ground for boasting!

**He suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
was crucified, died, and was buried.**  
**He descended to the dead.**  
**On the third day he rose again.**  
**He ascended into heaven,  
and is seated at the right hand of the Father.**  
**He will come again to judge the living and the dead.**  
**I believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the holy catholic Church,  
the communion of saints,  
the forgiveness of sins,  
the resurrection of the body,  
and the life everlasting. Amen.**

Almighty and merciful God, you raised up Gregory of Rome to be a servant of the servants of God, and inspired him to send missionaries to preach the Gospel to the English people: Preserve your church in the catholic and apostolic faith, that your people, being fruitful in every good work, may receive the crown of glory that never fades away; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. **Amen.**

## **Seasonal Collect**

Almighty and everlasting God, you hate nothing you have made and forgive the sins of all who are penitent: Create and make in us new and contrite hearts, that we, worthily lamenting our sins and acknowledging our wretchedness, may obtain of you, the God of all mercy, perfect remission and forgiveness; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. **Amen.**

## **A Prayer of St. Chrysostom**

**BCP p. 102**
